Romans 4

The book of Genesis opens with the creation project: God speaks the world and all that is in it into existing, bringing order out of chaos.

God's promises to Abraham (Abram): Genesis 12:1–4a; 15:1–8

This is my covenant with you and your descendants after you, the covenant you are to keep: Every male among you shall be circumcised. You are to undergo circumcision, and it will be the sign of the covenant between me and you. Genesis 17:10–11 (NIV)

What then (we) say (have) found Abraham the ancestor our according to flesh? Romans 4:1 (literal)

So what are we going to say? Are we going to find that Abraham is our ancestor on the basis of genealogy? Romans 4:1 (CEB)

Faith is the only sign of membership in God's new covenant family, of which Abraham is the father.
